Her true passion lies in health and wellness, having worked as a YMCA trainer and swim instructor, PE educator, and former owner of a local CrossFit gym, where she helped countless individuals achieve their fitness goals.

As a parent, professional, and passionate advocate, she brings invaluable insight and connections to our mission," said Sam Taylor, Chairman and Co-Founder of Swim With Purpose. That's why I'm deeply committed to making the Exum Center pool restoration a reality. This facility will offer life-changing opportunities for so many, and I'm honored to help facilitate this effort."

Hartley-Smith brings more than 20 years of experience in public service, with expertise in leadership, administration, and team collaboration. She currently serves as an Administrative Senior Specialist at the Kentucky Department for Public Health, supporting strategic operations and process improvement. Her past roles include Legislative Assistant for the Kentucky House GOP, Owner of CrossFit Unbridled, and

Bookkeeper for Franklin County Public Schools. She holds certifications as an Emergency Medical Training Professional, Certified Nurse Assistant and CrossFit Level 2 Trainer.
